1+1+1 in Philosophy

Model

Students who have completed 1 year postgraduate study at SCU can spend 1 year at Leeds for a master's degree, then return to SCU for the third year study of the postgraduate programme.

Students who have successfully completed studies at both SCU and Leeds will get degrees from both universities in 3 years.



1+1+1 in Philosophy

Entry Requirements

Passed all the elements of the first year of SCU's MA Programme achieving a minimum GPA of at least 75%

and

Obtain an overall IELTS score of 6.5 with no less than 6.0 in all components (or equivalent)

and

Provide a sample of written work



3+1+1 in History, English, Chemistry

Model

Students who have completed 3 years undergraduate study at SCU can spend 1 year at Leeds for a Study Abroad programme. Students who have successfully completed the 3+1 programme can continue with a 1 year Master's study at Leeds.

Students will get Master's degree from Leeds.



3+1+1 in History, English, Chemistry

Entry Requirements (Study Abroad)

Completed three years of study at SCU at relevant programme and maintained an overall average GPA of at least 75% during those years.

and

Obtain an overall IELTS score of 6.5 (6.0*) with no less than 6.0 (5.5*) in all components (or equivalent).

* For Chemistry



3+1+1 in History, English, Chemistry

Entry Requirements (Master's)

Successfully obtained a bachelor degree from SCU and achieved at least 75% in both overall average and relevant subjects.

and

Obtain an overall IELTS score of 6.5 with no less than 6.0 in all components (or equivalent).


