Covid-19 situation in QMUL, London and the UK

- More than 52 million people have had a first vaccine dose - 91% of over-12s. More than 48 million - 85% of over-12s - have had both doses.
- As a result many Covid restrictions have now been relaxed in the UK
- Face masks are commonly worn e.g. on public transport but are no longer compulsory
- Vaccine centre on our Mile End campus
- We have welcomed students to campus in-person in September 2021 and are teaching classes face to face

Partnership Programmes

- **4+1/ 5+1:** Students who have completed a Bachelors degree at SCU can apply to study a Postgraduate degree at Queen Mary.
Entry requirements: min. grade of 75 in their Bachelors degree from SCU
- **1+1+1:** Students complete the first year of the Masters at SCU, the second year at Queen Mary and the final year at SCU.
Entry requirements: min. grade of 75 in Bachelors degree and a min. grade of 75 from the SCU Masters first semester

English language support

- **Pre-sessional English – take a course before the start of your programme**
 - Choose from 5, 9 or 13 weeks

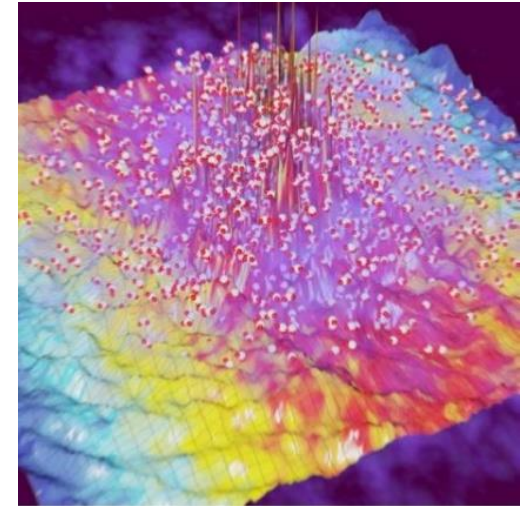

Fees and Costs

- **Tuition fee cost varies depending on the programme**
Sichuan students receive a 10% discount on tuition fees
- **Cost of living** is ~£1,334 per month.
- **Housing on campus** ranges from £137-£221 per week
- Excellent students from **4+1 / 5+1 / 1+1+1** programme (only for Science and Engineering programmes) with an overall academic grade of 85% from their Bachelor's degree will be awarded a partnership Scholarship of £5,000.

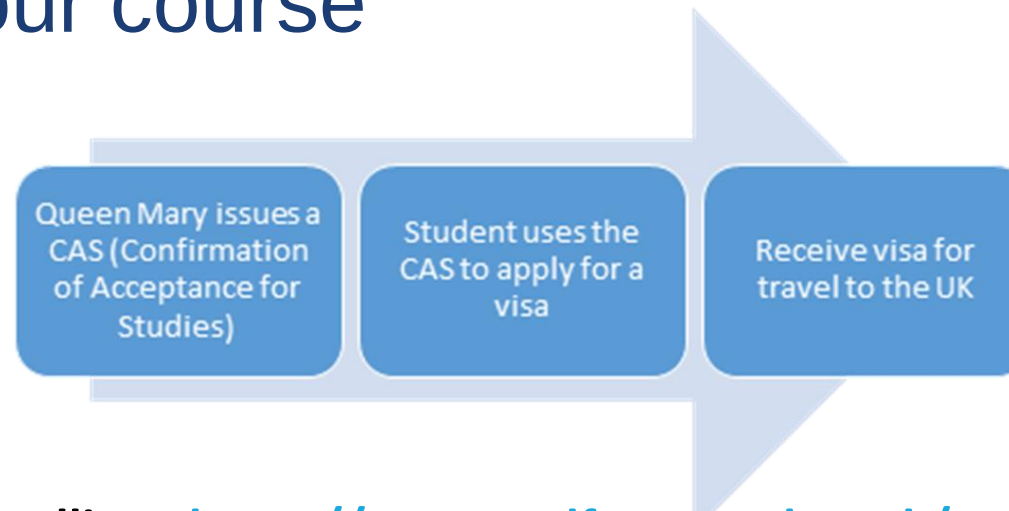
Apply for Housing

- You need a CAS to apply for your visa
- You can apply for a CAS once you have received an unconditional offer from Queen Mary from 6 months before the start date of your course

Working in the UK

- During your studies, you are permitted to work for a maximum of 20 hours per week.

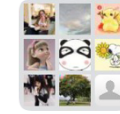

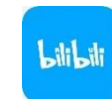
